Health, Hygiene, Safety and Wellbeing


To ensure a safe and healthy environment for our students, the following routine measures are regularly implemented at MGS:

- Pest Control: Routine fogging was conducted on November 21, 2025, both within and immediately surrounding the school premises to maintain a pest-free area.
- Cleaning and Disinfection: Deep cleaning and comprehensive disinfection of the facilities are carried out every Saturday.
- Smoking Prohibition: MGS strictly enforces a no-smoking policy within the school grounds and in the immediate vicinity outside. This measure is taken to protect students



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from health hazards and negative influences. Public awareness banners concerning this policy are displayed outside the school.



On November 18, our school successfully administered essential booster vaccines to various primary grades. Grade 1 students received the DT (Diphtheria and Tetanus) booster, while students in Grades 2 and 5 received the Td (Tetanus and reduced-Diphtheria) booster. These vaccinations are a vital part of our school health program, offering continued protection for our students against diphtheria and tetanus.

Our Preschool students underwent a comprehensive health screening on November 19. This routine activity helps MGS track student health milestones and identify any early signs of developmental delays, allowing us to recommend immediate and effective support and intervention
